

CFRW NORTHERN DIVISION CONFERENCE STANDING RULES

1. All elected officers, appointed officers, members of all standing committees, Presidents of all Northern Division clubs, or alternates appointed in writing by the Club Presidents, the CFRW Vice President North and CFRW Northern Division Past Presidents in good standing are members of the Board of Directors and are the official delegates who are eligible to make motions and vote. Non-delegate members are permitted to speak to a motion with the permission of the assembly.
2. One-third of the members shall constitute a quorum.
3. The privilege of offering motions and voting shall be limited to members of the Board of Directors.
4. A guest cannot vote, speak, or make motions, or be counted to establish a quorum.
5. At all times, members and guests shall wear the badges issued by the Registration Committee upon registration for admission to the assembly hall, and to facilitate identification and seating.
6. Members shall be seated and doors are to remain closed during opening ceremonies and during a vote. Members waiting to enter shall be admitted at the discretion of the Pages.
7. When addressing the Chair, a member shall use the microphone and state her name, the name of her club and Northern Division title.
8. Motions longer than ten words shall be written, signed and given to a Page for delivery to the Chair.
9. No member shall speak in debate more than once on the same question on the same day nor longer than two minutes, without permission of the assembly, granted by two-thirds vote without debate.
10. Members are requested to be in their seats five minutes before time for the meeting to convene.
11. Cell phones and pagers must be turned off when the meeting begins unless special permission has been granted in advance by the Chair.
12. The Conference shall be open to all members of the CFRW Northern Division and guests.
